### Questions on the KAMRA™ Inlay Surgical Procedure

The following questions cover important information contained in this information packet. Please mark the correct answer. If you should have any questions, please list your questions for Dr. Kornmehl on the back of this sheet for you and Dr. Kornmehl to review during your consultation.

1. TRUE or FALSE Presbyopia occurs as one ages because the lens inside your eye becomes less flexible.
2. TRUE or FALSE The KAMRA™ inlay is a laser surgical procedure that significantly reduces your dependence on reading glasses.
3. TRUE or FALSE All patients obtain excellent reading vision one day after surgery.
4. TRUE or FALSE The KAMRA™ inlay does not decrease my peripheral vision but may cause some dimness in the eye with the implant.
